Is the journal title available as part of the library print journal collection?

Check our journal holdings list in either site library or on our website. Go to www.whnt.nhs.uk/library to search the library catalogue.

Find the journal on the shelf and photocopy the article you require. Please make sure you are aware of up-to-date Copyright legislation.

Is the journal title available as part of the NHS e-journals collection?

To check, go to NHS Evidence at www.evidence.nhs.uk. Select 'Journals and Databases', then 'Access Journals'.

Then enter the name of the journal you are looking for in the Search box.

N.B. To access full content, you need an NHS Athens username and password. Register from the NHS Evidence homepage (www.evidence.nhs.uk) or ask library staff for more information.

Follow the links to access the PDF (Portable Document Format) of the article you require and print it off.
