How to register for Map of Medicine (MoM)

What is the Map of Medicine?

The Map of Medicine (MoM) is an online clinical knowledge resource, designed and developed by health care professionals for health care professionals, to provide specialist-level information to the right person at the right time.



The Map of Medicine provides 24/7 access to evidence-based clinical pathways, grouped into broad areas of clinical practice, via an intuitive web-based interface. Each 'map' visually represents a patient's journey through the healthcare system.

Pathways can be localised by the organisation to include local administrative information, e.g. contact details, clinic information, opening times, links to websites or intranet sites etc. Local clinical information can also be added, e.g. adding to or changing national pathways to include local information.

How can I register for the Map of Medicine?

Go to <http://wirral.mapofmedicine.com>
Click on 'Register now'.

You will need to return to this page in future any time you want to log in to the Map of Medicine.

Fill in the online registration form with your details.

Your details will be confirmed; please check them carefully. If any of the information is incorrect, please contact the Project Support Manager (details below).
