Creating and using an NHS Athens account

What is an NHS Athens account?

Athens is the brand name of a system that controls access to online resources such as e-journals and databases.

When you register for an NHS Athens account, you will create a username and password. You will need your username and password to login to any of the free NHS resources available to you.

View a list of all your free NHS resources by logging in to the *MyAthens* (www.athensams.net/myathens) web pages with your NHS Athens username and password.

Who can have an NHS Athens account?

Anyone working for or on placement within the NHS in England can register for an NHS Athens account.

What if I have a university Athens account?

Your university Athens username and password will only allow you to access online resources purchased by your university; you will need to register for an NHS Athens account in addition.

How do I register for an NHS Athens account?

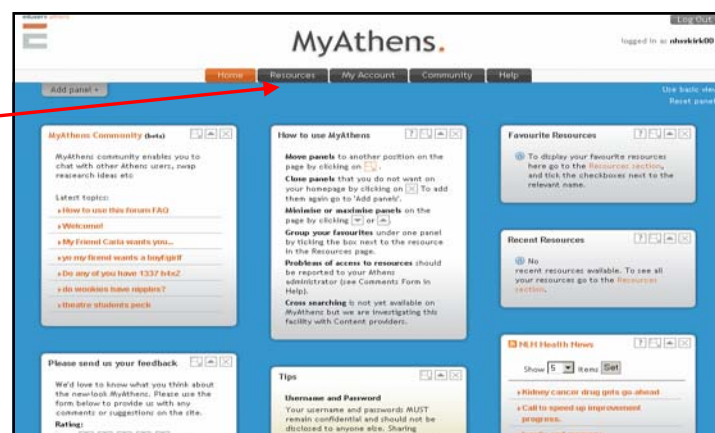
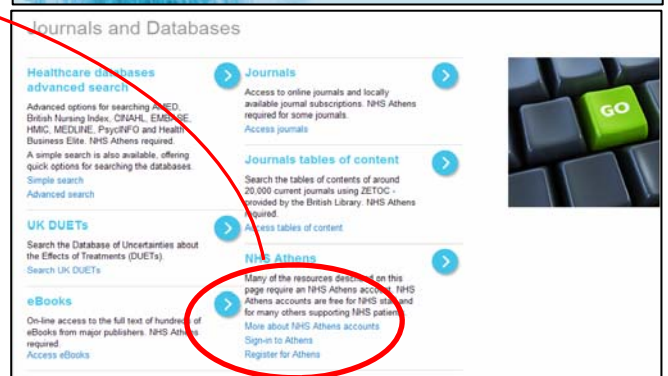
IMPORTANT: In order to register you must either use an NHS networked computer OR use an nhs.net email account or your request will fail.

Go to: www.evidence.nhs.uk

1. Click on 'Journals and Databases'
2. Click on 'Register for Athens'
3. Search for your employing organisation by typing in Wirral and **carefully** selecting the correct Trust (students on placement, please select the NHS Trust that you are on placement with).
4. Enter your personal details and select the tick box to accept the terms and conditions before selecting 'Submit'.
5. Your NHS Athens account details will be confirmed on screen; make a note of your username.
6. An account activation email will be sent to your email address. Follow the instructions in the email. *You must activate your account before you can use it.*
7. You will be asked to choose a password. Follow the on-screen instructions and you will be taken to the **MyAthens website**, where you can view a list of all your NHS resources in the **Resources** section.

On the *MyAthens* website you can also:

- View all the free NHS resources you are eligible to access in the **Resources** section
- Reset your password or change your e-mail address in the **My Account** section
