How to access the Map of Medicine (MoM)

What is the Map of Medicine?

The Map of Medicine (MoM) is an online clinical knowledge resource, designed and developed by health care professionals for health care professionals, to provide specialist-level information to the right person at the right time.

It is a collection of evidence-based, practice-informed care maps which connect all the knowledge and services around a clinical condition.

The Map of Medicine provides 24/7 access to evidence-based clinical pathways, grouped into broad areas of clinical practice, via an intuitive web-based interface. Each 'map' visually represents a patient's journey through the healthcare system.

There are a number of 'localised' pathways which have been approved for use across the Wirral local health community. These contain local procedural and administrative information, including referral forms.

Please be aware that locally approved pathways will be clearly marked as such. All other pathways are nationally accredited but are to be used as reference only.

Click on 'Log in via Athens'

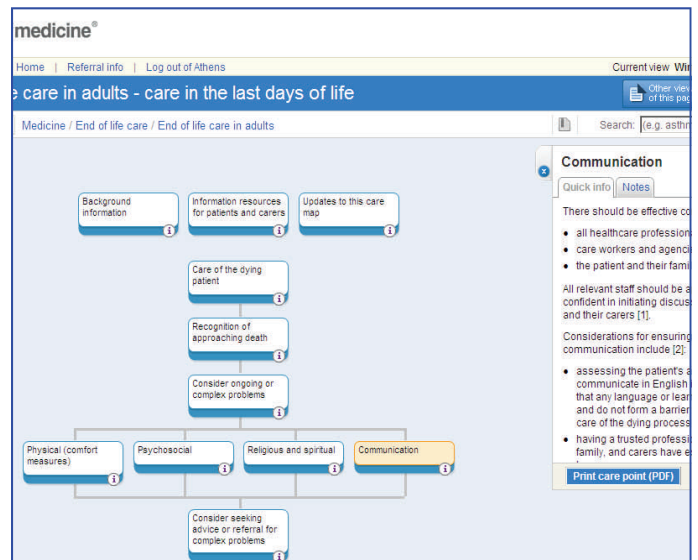
